

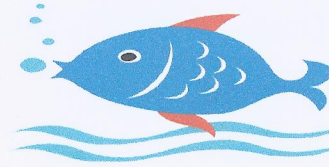
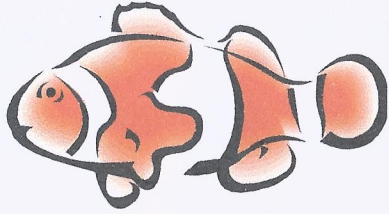
Keila's Exciting Day

Title: Keila's Exciting Day



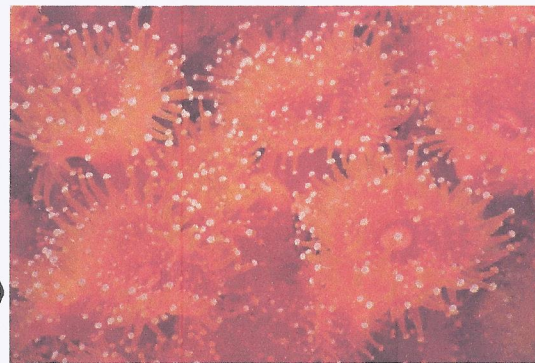
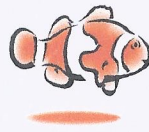

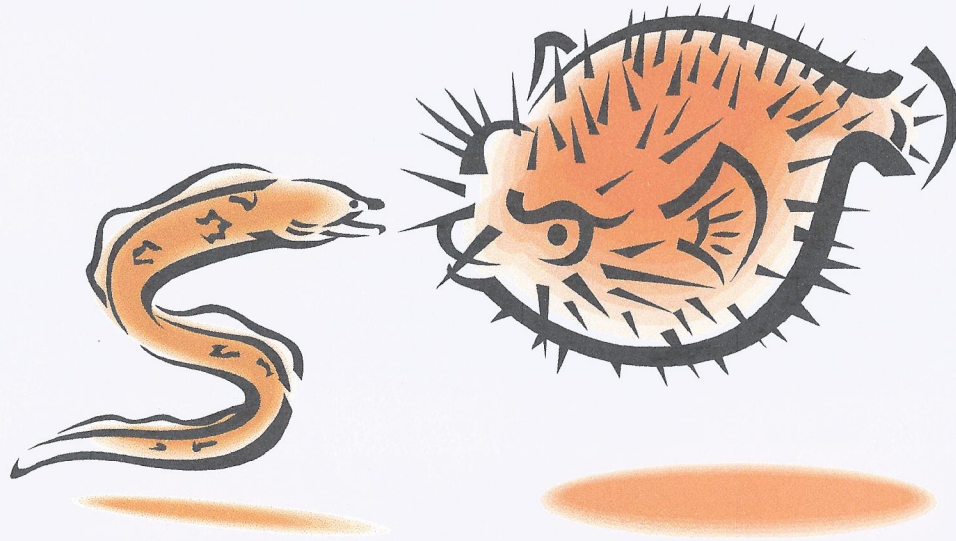
